The Wraparound Booking system is now live for registrations with the system opening for booking on Monday 10th October.

It is important to note that any outstanding debt on your ParentPay account for wraparound needs to be cleared as you will be unable to make any future bookings until outstanding balances have been paid.

All bookings that are held on our system have been passed over to the Childcare Booking team and will be added to your account. Once the portal opens for bookings on Monday, please login to your account to ensure the booking is correct and think about whether it is a permanent or ad-hoc booking that you require.

Please note Childcare Bookings are unable to add any bookings to your account until you are fully registered and have entered a debit card and emergency contact details.

# Nasal Flu Vaccination

The flu vaccine will be offered to all primary school and SEND children up until the day before their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday this year. Nasal flu vaccination is delivered in school. There are some occasions where an injection is the most appropriate route for vaccination for some children. The consent form that the link below takes you to is for Nasal Flu, if you select NO, you will be asked a series of questions to establish if your child is eligible for an injection.
