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## SPORTING UPDATE from Mr. Jeff

### Our PESSPA Programme

In this section you will find out all information on what is currently happening in our PESSPA programme at Staynor Hall!

#### **PE (Physical Education)**

Classes have up to two lessons a week of planned and progressive lessons based around a variety of units of learning. We have a broad and varied transferable skills curriculum which focuses on developing the whole child (through our four learning umbrellas - social, cognitive, physical and emotional)

This is what our children will be learning in PE after the new year:

- EYFS = Developing fundamental movement skills through Gymnastics
- KS1 = Creating individual sequences in Gymnastics with Mr Jeff and Dance with their class teacher
- KS2 = LSK2 Creating partner sequences in gymnastics and in LKS2 creating group sequences in gymnastics with Mr Jeff. All KS2 classes will also be doing Orienteering with their class teacher.

#### **SS (School Sport)**

Please keep an eye out for any school fixtures after the Christmas period. We will be looking to arrange some fixtures in various sports with other schools and also attend some local cluster events and competitions

- LSK2 skipping festival - One of our LKS2 classes will be attending a skipping festival at Selby High School on Tuesday 7th February. This will be in school time.

#### **PA (Physical activity)**

In this section you will find out what we have been doing to keep our children active during and after school

- Year 3 and 4 have a dance after school club starting on a Friday in the first week back after new years.
- Mr Jeff is currently running a KS1 dodgeball club

### I'M A PARENT

All children and young people across North Yorkshire can get involved in a range of holiday activities, with free places and lunch for children receiving benefits-related Free School Meals.

If your child is eligible for benefits-related Free School Meals, they will receive a letter from their school with a unique code. This will enable you to book school holiday activities that are part of the FEAST programme for free. You can browse through the list of activities on our website.

If you think your child is eligible but they haven't received a code, please request a code using the form on our website.

### I'M A SCHOOL

Named letters of eligibility for the FEAST programme are sent directly to schools to give to pupils. If there is a child missing that should be eligible, email [hello@northyorkshiretogether.co.uk](mailto:hello@northyorkshiretogether.co.uk)

Schools can also get involved in the FEAST programme in a number of ways - as an activity provider, a host venue or their kitchen facilities can be used to supply food to other providers.
