We have had a fantastic week in school with lots of extra curricular activities taking place.

I felt so proud to attend the Yorkshire Dance Festival on Sunday afternoon where we saw a group of our children from KS2 perform a wonderful dance to a mash up of three songs, which were, Here comes the rain, Cry for me and The Sun. The theme for the festival was Picture this and so inspiration was taken and a vision created to look through the rain at what's coming next for brighter times ahead. Miss Wylie choreographed the whole dance and worked with the children every week. The children were one of 15 schools taking part and the experience they had at performing to more than 1000 people was incredible. In total over 300 schools and colleges took part over a number of weekends.

Some of our children also had the amazing opportunity to walk out with the England and New Zealand womens rugby league teams for the semi-final of the World Cup. The children then stood with the team to observe a minute's silence for Remembrance and the national anthems as well as seeing the mighty Haka from the New Zealand team. Although the England Women battled valiantly, New Zealand came out winners 20-6. It was a great experience for our children to not only be mascots for the game amongst 7000 spectators but also see a massive spectacle for Women's sport and for York to host a semi-final of the Rugby league World cup.

Without the dedication of staff, going above and beyond their daily role these opportunities could not happen, sincere thanks goes to all staff for the additional work they are doing for our school community.
