A Message from Mrs. Winter

We have had another wonderful week in school and I felt proud to show Chris Chambers, our Link Governor from the Board of Trustees, around to spend time in classrooms, talking to children and having lunch with them. I would like to share some of the report he has written about the time he spent with us.

I was taken on a tour of the building. I was very impressed. There is a great atmosphere everywhere. The classrooms are large, well lit and feel welcoming. The children are wonderful. Respectful, but not reticent. There is a behavioural ethos which is displayed in every room and whose standards are quietly but rigorously enforced. In each classroom is a tent where children can go for a period of personal reflection. We looked outside at a new storage facility, an area of boundary fence that is about to be planted with climbing bushes and a new play area. The children are obviously in the hands of a highly professional team and this starts at the top, as it does with the governing body.

We finished off by having lunch with the children. The younger children all have a school lunch, but the older children have a choice. There were some impressively healthy pack-ups on display, several of which had been prepared by the children themselves.

It was a wonderful visit and I came away feeling very positive and full of admiration for the SHPA teaching and admin team and the LGB.


