Our PESSPA Programme

In this section you will find out all information on what is currently happening in our PESSPA programme at Staynor Hall!

PE (Physical Education)

Classes have up to two lessons a week of planned and progressive lessons based around a variety of units of learning. We have a broad and varied transferable skills curriculum which focuses on developing the whole child (through our four learning umbrellas - social, cognitive, physical and emotional)

This is what our children will be learning in PE after the new year:

- EYFS = Developing fundamental movement skills through Gymnastics
- KS1 = Creating individual sequences in Gymnastics with Mr Jeff and Dance with their class teacher
- KS2 = LSK2 Creating partner sequences in gymnastics and in UKS2 creating group sequences in gymnastics with Mr Jeff. All KS2 classes will also be doing Orienteering with their class teacher.

SS (School Sport)

Please keep an eye out for any school fixtures after the Christmas period. We will be looking to arrange some fixtures in various sports with other schools and also attend some local cluster events and competitions

- LSK2 skipping festival - One of our LKS2 classes will be attending a skipping festival at Selby High School on Tuesday 7th February. This will be in school time.

PA (Physical activity)

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
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School Meals

PARKING

We have received a number of concerns regarding parking at school drop off and pick-up, more particularly where cars are double-parked opposite the school gates.

This is a concern that we know many of you share and is a long-standing issue due to the road layout around school.

If parking and driving are inconsiderate, then road conditions for both drivers and pedestrians (children and adults) become increasingly dangerous. **In the interest of the children's safety**, we ask that you be mindful of where and how you park and wherever possible we encourage you to walk to school.

When you are walking to school, please remain on the pavement, rather than walking on the road. If your children walk to school independently, can you please remind them about when and where it is safe to cross the roads.

We thank you for your continued support in keeping our school community safe.

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Plasters

Please note if your child wears earrings please may we politely remind you these need to be removed on PE days or you can cover them with a plaster.

The plasters we hold in the medical room are to be used for accidents so we would appreciate your support and ask you to cover your child's earrings before your child comes to school, or if they are old enough, you send your child to school with plasters so they can cover them over themselves.
